## SBHR 2019

We try to hold the Rally in a different part of the UK each year and this time for our special celebration of 50 years of the Fellowship we are going to a new venue near Oswestry with excellent road access and facilities. To mark our 50 years we want as many people to be able to attend as possible, so we are offering a **50% discount** to anyone who has not been to the National Rally before.

This year's rally will include four mornings of Bible Studies with David Lyttle (while the younger generations are catered for by our children and youth workers). We also have a programme dedicated to the older youth (Y10+). The theme for the rally is '**Faithful God**'.

On top of all this we have family friendly holiday times, with fun activities, fete games and entertainment by invited performers in the evenings. We also guarantee you will still have time available to explore and enjoy the lovely area around about as there is plenty for you to see and do.

## DIRECTIONS

**The rally begins at 2 pm on Thursday 23rd May.**

**Please plan your journey so that you do not arrive before this time.**

- From S and SW on M5 – take the M6 North and exit at junction 10A onto the M54. Continue on M54, after junction 6 it becomes the A5 towards Shrewsbury and Oswestry. Follow the A5 for 29 miles to the A495 (third exit), take this exit towards Whitchurch. The showground entrance is on the left, called Garrison Road, after 300 yards.
- From SE and E on M6 - exit at junction 10A onto the M54 then as above.
- From N, NW, NE on M6 – leave motorway at Junction 12 onto A5 West and follow the A5 until it merges with the M54 then continue on the A5 for 29 miles, then as above.
- From West – follow the A5 East to the A495 roundabout, take the first exit towards Whitchurch, the showground entrance is on the left after 300 yards.

## COSTS

There is no cost difference for tents, caravans and motorhomes. We do not charge for children or full time students under 18. All units will be charged for at least one adult. If you are able to volunteer to help at the time of booking, that would be greatly appreciated and helps with our planning.

- A one off rally fee of £10
- A pitch fee of £13 per night
- £9 per night per adult
- £5 per night for over 18's in full time education
- Non-member fee of an additional £3 per unit per night

This means that a family unit of 2 adults plus children will pay £31 per night. A single person will only pay £22 per night.

**Gift Aid:** Rally Fees are not eligible for Gift Aid however any additional gifts including visitors' voluntary donations are eligible.
