# Who are we ?

The Caravanners and Campers Christian Fellowship - in short CCCF. We are the biggest Christian interdenominational caravanning and camping organisation in England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales. Over 50 years young (founded in 1969), we have about 200 member units and run approximately 60 rallies each year (i.e. camping, caravanning and motorhome meet ups, day meets or events).

## What do we do ?

We are a holidaying fellowship run completely by volunteers which makes what we do fantastic value for money. We offer a mix of rally formats with Christian Fellowship together with family fun, centred on our Christian Faith.

We arrange a variety of regional weekend rallies and other events where you are always guaranteed a wonderful welcome. Secondly, we hold a marvellous ten day annual national rally over the Spring Bank Holiday aptly named 'Spring Bank Holiday Rally' (SBHR), catchy we know!

## SBHR 2022

We try to hold the Rally in a different part of the UK each year but following our special celebration of 50 years of the Fellowship in 2019 we are going to a favourite venue near Oswestry. There will be showers, toilets and electric hookup for each unit. We want as many people to be able to attend as possible, so we are repeating our offer of a **50% discount** to anyone who has not been to the CCCF National Rally before.

This year's rally will include four mornings of Bible Studies with Rob White (while the younger generations are catered for by our children's workers and youth workers). We also have a programme dedicated to the older youth (Y10+). The theme for the rally is **Tune in to God, 'Lord teach us to pray' Luke 11 v1.**

On top of all this we have family friendly holiday times, fun activities, fete games and entertainment by invited performers in the evenings. We can also guarantee you will still have time available to explore and enjoy the lovely area around about as there is plenty for you to see and do.

## Rob and Marion White

Rob and Marion are leading us in our Bible studies

Until recently Rob & Marion lived in Wilmslow (8 miles south of Manchester) where they've been church-planting with Revolution bar as a venue. Rob was the Senior Minister of Poynton Baptist Church for 12 years, then led an apostolic network "Mainstream". Before that he was National Director of Youth For Christ in the UK & Vice-Chairman of their International Board. Once upon a time Rob was a sales rep & manager/buyer in a large Perfumery Dept. in a leading Department Store! Marion trained as a teacher.

They were involved in Spring Harvest speaking & leadership for 29 years (can't be true!). Marion became very involved in speaking out about human trafficking, having been out to Mumbai and, as a result, she & Rob together with Ben & Deb Cooley organised a major event in November 2008 called The Stand, which attracted nearly 6,000 people to the Birmingham NEC, which gave rise to co-founding Hope for Justice, whose mission is to investigate cases of human trafficking & rescue the victims, also to call the church to action in fighting against it.

Marion has been part of the founding of Press Red, an organisation which is raising awareness of violence against women, nationally & globally, and is a Trustee. Rob continues his interest in young people by working as a Trustee of The Message Trust (remember The Tribe?).

Years ago Rob & Marion wrote a book together, "My Family: My Church", & have also written numerous articles. Rob has more recently written 'Teach us to Pray' & regularly used to broadcast with the BBC. They have 3 daughters and 6 grandchildren and, when they say that, they realise they're not as young as they used to be!



## COSTS

There is no cost difference for tents, caravans and motorhomes. We do not charge for children or full time students under 18. All units will be charged for at least one adult. If you are able to volunteer to help at the time of booking, that would be greatly appreciated and helps with our planning.

- A one off rally fee of £10
- A pitch fee of £15 per night
- £9.50 per night per adult
- £5 per night for over 18's in full time education
- Non-member fee of an additional £3 per unit per night

This means that a family unit of 2 adults plus children will pay £34 per night plus the one off rally fee. A single person will only pay £24.50 per night.

**Gift Aid:** Rally Fees are not eligible for Gift Aid, however any additional gifts including visitors' voluntary donations are eligible.

## NEVER BEEN BEFORE ?

If this would be your first ever Spring Bank Holiday Rally then the above costs will all have

## 50% off

Which means that a family unit of 2 adults plus children will pay £17 per night (plus a Rally Fee of only £5). A single person will only pay £12.25 per night.

There is no further reduction, for example for the meals on site. You would pay the normal food price if you choose to use the burger van and to join in the Hog Roast, Cream Tea and Friday Night meals.

## **EASY PAYMENTS**

We are happy to arrange for stage payments in advance to avoid having to pay the full cost of the rally in one payment.

## **DIRECTIONS**

**The rally begins at 2 pm on Thursday 26th May.  
Please plan your journey so that you do not arrive before this time.**

- From S and SW on M5 – take the M6 North and exit at junction 10A onto the M54. Continue on M54, after junction 6 it becomes the A5 towards Shrewsbury and Oswestry. Follow the A5 for 29 miles to the A495 (third exit), take this exit towards Whitchurch, Garrison Road. The showground entrance is on the left after 300 yards.
- From SE and E on M6 - exit at junction 10A onto the M54 then as above.
- From N, NW, NE on M6 – At junction 20A, Use the left lanes to merge North onto M56 towards Wales/Chester/Runcorn. At junction 15, exit onto M53 towards Chester/Wrexham. Continue onto the North Wales Expressway/A55. At junction 38, take the A483 exit to Wrexham/Chester. At A483/A5 Gledrid Roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto A483/A5. Continue on A5 until Whittington Roundabout, take the 1st exit onto A495, Garrison Road. The showground entrance is on the left after 300 yards.
- From West – follow the A5 East to the A495 roundabout, take the first exit towards Whitchurch, the showground entrance is on the left after 300 yards.
