# MEETINGS FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH

Wow Kids (Ages 3 - Reception) Champions (School Years 1- 5) Sprite (School Years 6 - 9) Youth (Year 10 Upwards)



### PRICES

There is no Rally fee difference for tents, caravans and motorhomes. We do not charge for children or full time students under 18. All units will be charged for at least one adult.

- A one off rally fee of £10
- A pitch fee of £16 per night
- £11 per night per adult
- £5 per night for over 18's in full time education
- Non-member fee of an additional £3 per unit per night

This means that a family unit of 2 adult CCCF members plus children will pay £38 per night plus a £10 rally fee . A single person CCCF member will pay £27 per night plus a £10 rally fee.

If you are able to volunteer to help at the time of booking, that would be greatly appreciated and helps with our planning.

**Gift Aid**: Rally Fees are not eligible for Gift Aid, however any additional gifts including visitors' voluntary donations are eligible. You can book for SBHR online, please visit *www.cccf.org.uk/sbhr* to complete your booking form.

### **NEVER BEEN BEFORE?**

If this would be your first ever Spring Bank Holiday Rally then the above costs will all have...

#### **50% OFF RALLY FEES**

This means that a CCCF member family unit of 2 adults plus children will only pay £19 per night plus a £5 rally fee or a single person CCCF member will only pay £13.50 per night plus a £5 rally fee.

First time attendees will however pay the standard food prices for any meals bought on site E.g. If you choose to buy from the burger van or to join in the Hog Roast, Cream Tea and Friday Night meals.

### EASY PAYMENTS

We are happy to arrange for stage payments in advance to avoid having to pay the full cost of the rally in one payment.

## FIND THE VENUE

#### The rally begins at 2 pm on Thursday 23rd May. Please plan your journey so that you do not arrive before that time.

**From the East (ie. M11, Cambridge),** take Jct 24B (A1307 - Huntingdon, Godmanchester & St Ives). Turn right at  $1^{st}$  roundabout, go over A14, then turn left ( $1^{st}$  exit) at  $2^{nd}$  roundabout. Proceed along this dual carriageway to the junction with the A1096 (signposted Biggleswade (B1040) & St Ives A1096). Follow signs to St Ives. (The A1307 is number which has been given to the old A14).

**From the West (ie. A1, Midlands),** take Jct 23 (A1198 – Royston, Godmanchester & St Ives). Turn left at roundabout ( $1^{st}$  exit) towards Huntingdon, Godmanchester & St Ives. Continue straight on until the junction with the A1307. Turn right ( $3^{rd}$  exit) onto the slip road towards Cambridge (A1307) & St Ives (A1096). Continue to the junction with the A1096 (Signposted Biggleswade, Hilton (B1040) & St Ives A1096). Follow signs to St Ives.

From A1 (North or South). Get onto A14 towards Cambridge and follow directions as above from the West.

**Burleigh Hill farm (burleighhillfarmcampsite.co.uk) postcode PE27 3LY** is situated on the B1040 Somersham Road, about 2 miles North East of St Ives town centre.

#### In the "What 3 Words" website or App;

Leaving St Ives on the B1040 follow the CCCF sign to turn left into a farm road to Burleigh hill farm at ///gems.catchers.slider. Drive down the farm road, you will reach Burleigh hill farm near ///donates.shaped.plotter.
